Purpose of the Study

This study, authorized by the Pennsylvania Off-Highway Vehicle Association and the USDA Forest Service-Allegheny National Forest, was conducted to assess the impact that off-highway vehicle (OHV) users of Allegheny National Forest trails have on the economy of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. For purposes of this study, OHVs are defined as all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) and trail bikes.

Methodology

A two-page mail questionnaire, accompanied by a cover letter from the Pennsylvania Off-Highway Vehicle Association, was sent to a systematic random sample of 500 households owning one or more off-highway vehicles from a mailing list provided by the Pennsylvania Off-Highway Vehicle Association. One hundred and fifty households completed and returned the questionnaire, representing a return of 30%. Seventy-five (75) percent of the sample households owning one or more OHVs (see OHV User Study) stated that they took one or more trips annually to ride trails in the Allegheny National Forest. Summary statistics were utilized in tabulating and analyzing the data.

Presentation of the Data

The data gleaned from the questionnaires are presented in the following manner: (1) a tabular summary of the economic impact data; (2) an overall summary of the specific data reported in the questionnaires; and (3) a tabular presentation of findings for each of the items on the questionnaire. Appropriate computations were performed and presented within the appropriate table.

An Overall Summary of the Data Collected

The data presented here are taken from the results of the information collected in the completed questionnaires from a sample of 150 households owning one or more off-highway vehicles and taking one or more trips annually to ride the trails in the Allegheny National Forest (ANF). In most cases, *the median was used to represent averages*.

Average number of annual OHV riding trips made to the Allegheny National Forest: 44% of OHV households make from 2 to 4 annual riding trips to the ANF, while an additional 26% of households make from 5 to 8 annual trips. The median number of annual trips per household is 3. (See Table 1, p. 6)

Average length of stay during each OHV riding trip to the Allegheny National Forest: 55% of OHV households spend an average of 2 days during each riding trip to the ANF, while an additional 23% of households spend an average of 1 day or less during each riding trip. The average length of stay during each riding trip to the ANF is 2 days.

(See Table 2, p. 7)

Type of OHV ridden when visiting the ANF: 46% of households ride an ATV on ANF trails, and an additional 30% of households ride trail bikes. 22% of households ride both ATVs and trail bikes on ANF trails. (See Table 3, p. 8)

Whether OHV owners ride alone or with others on ANF trails: 48% of households ride in groups of 2 to 4 on ANF trails, while an additional 47% of households ride in groups of 5 or more. (See Table 4, p. 9)

Type of group with which OHV owners ride most often on ANF trails: 69% of households ride with a peer group on ANF trails, and an additional 23% of households ride with a family group. (See Table 5, p. 10)

<u>Type of lodging used for overnight stays in the Allegheny National Forest</u>: 33% of households stay in a hotel or motel, while an additional 18% stay in a seasonal residence near ANF trails. (See Table 6, p. 11)

Access to OHV trails as a factor in decision to own property near the Allegheny National Forest trails: 62% of households did not consider access to OHV trails as important in their decision to own property near ANF trails, though almost one-third (30%) did consider access to OHV trails in making such a decision. (See Table 7, p. 12)

Average annual amount spent on property-related costs in the Allegheny National Forest area: 41% of households spend between \$501 and \$1,000 annually on property-related costs in the ANF area, while 38% of households spend an average of more than \$1,000 annually on such property-related costs in the ANF area. OHV households spend an average of \$750 annually for property-related costs in the ANF area. (See Table 8, p. 13)

Average amount spent for lodging on each OHV riding trip to the Allegheny

<u>National Forest</u>: 49% of households spend up to \$50 for lodging on each OHV riding trip to the ANF, while an additional 32% of households spend from \$51 to \$100 per OHV riding trip to the ANF. The average amount spent for lodging on each OHV riding trip to the ANF is \$50. (See Table 9, p. 14)

Average amount spent for food on each OHV riding trip to the Allegheny National

Forest: 42% of households spend from \$51 to \$100 for food on each OHV riding trip to the ANF, and an additional 36% of households spend up to \$50 per OHV riding trip to the ANF. The average amount spent for food on each OHV riding trip to the ANF is \$75. (See Table 10, p. 15)

Average amount spent for fuel on each OHV riding trip to the Allegheny National

Forest: 42% of households spend between \$26 and \$50 for fuel on each OHV riding trip to the ANF, while an additional 27% spend between \$51 and \$75 per OHV riding trip to the ANF. The average amount spent for fuel on each OHV riding trip to the ANF is \$60. (See Table 11, p. 16)

Average amount spent for OHV-related items on each OHV riding trip to the ANF: 42% of households spend between \$26 and \$50 for OHV-related items on each OHV riding trip to the ANF, and an additional 32% of households spend up to \$25 per OHV riding trip to the ANF. The average amount spent for OHV-related items on each OHV riding trip to the ANF is \$35. (See Table 12, p. 17)

Average amount spent for non-OHV-related items (e.g., souvenirs, clothing, and all other such expenses) on each OHV riding trip to the Allegheny National Forest: 49% of households spend up to \$25 for non-OHV-related items on OHV trips to ANF trails, while an additional 33% of households spend between \$26 and \$50 for such items on each OHV trip to the ANF. The average amount spent for non-OHV-related items on each OHV trip to the ANF is \$25. (See Table 13, p. 18)

Types of OHV riding experiences deemed most important to riders visiting the Allegheny National Forest: Those types of riding experiences deemed most important to riders visiting the ANF include family rides, rides on trails with plenty of mud and hills, just plain fun rides, rides on trails that are well maintained, rides on longer trails, rides of 2 hours or more with restaurants available nearby, rides in areas with adequate parking, more access to riding trails throughout the year, rides on trails providing more diversity than dirt roads, and rides on a greater variety of trails. (See Table 14, p. 19)

<u>Types of OHV trail system improvements deemed most important to riders visiting</u> <u>the Allegheny National Forest</u>: OHV trail system improvements most desired by riders visiting the ANF include more trail areas, more technically challenging trails, more access to trails when riders would like to use them, good signage along trails, and less dirt roads designated as trails. (See Table 15, p. 20)

OHV trails ridden most often in the Allegheny National Forest: The ANF trails ridden in order of their popularity with OHV riders are Marienville, Rocky Gap, Timberline, and Willow Creek. The Marienville Trail is considerably more popular than the other ANF trails. (See Table 16, p. 21)

Average amount of time spent on an Allegheny National Forest trail during each riding day: 70% of households spend between 4 and 8 hours on an ANF trail during each riding day. The average amount of time spent on an ANF trail during a riding day is 6 hours. (See Table 17, p. 22)

Willingness to support OHV trail improvements in the Allegheny National Forest through a user fee: 73% of households would approve of a user fee for improving OHV trails in the ANF. Only 18% of households would absolutely disapprove of such a user fee. (See Table 18, p, 23)

Willingness to make return trips to the Allegheny National Forest for other activities as a result of being introduced to the ANF by OHV riding trips: 69% of households are willing to visit the ANF for other activities because they were first introduced to the ANF through OHV riding trips; slightly over one-third (36%) of households are not willing to use the ANF for activities other than OHV riding. (See Table 19, p. 24)









Owning Property Related to OHV Trail Access



Property-Related Costs



Overnight Accommodations Expense















Support for Trail Improvements Through User Fees




